- ❖ Each team will consist of 14 players (with a minimum of 8 players). We recommend at least 4 females in Mixed teams. In mixed teams there must be a maximum of three males and a least one female on the field at any given time.
- ❖ All players must take the field in the same coloured playing shirts, which must be numbered.
- ❖ Bare feet are not permitted while playing. All players must wear shoes.
- ❖ Touch NZ 8th edition Playing Rules of Touch will apply.
- ❖ Schools must enter a mixed team in a particular age group before they can enter a boys or girls team.
- ❖ Boys are permitted to play in both the mixed and the boys competition, however the mixed team must only have the registered boys playing.
- ❖ Unregistered players may incur forfeit of match points.
- ❖ Misconduct will not be tolerated. At all times players, officials, parents and supporters will respect each other as well as the referees & coordinators involved in the competition. The promotion of fair play and honesty is paramount.
- ❖ All players participate at their own risk.
- ❖ In all matters pertaining to the match, the referee's decision is final. Only the registered TEAM MANAGER may lay any complaint to the competition coordinator.
- ❖ The Touch Papamoa Junior Touch competition reserves the right to refuse entry to any player or team.
- ❖ The Touch Papamoa Junior Touch competition reserves the right to remove any player or team from the competition where the above rules are not adhered to.
- ❖ Each team is to nominate two referees (parents or those over the age of 13). Teams will be required to provide a referee for their games. The Touch Module Referee course is available free of charge at www.touchnz.co.nz
- ❖ Touch Papamoa is affiliated to the Bay of Plenty Touch Association and Touch New Zealand. This will provide an opportunity for selected junior players to trial for representative teams at Regional and National level.
- ❖ All schools are to provide details of each teams Coach and Manager, to enable Touch Papamoa to communicate directly. Coach and Manager must be present with the team for games.
